

Federation of Window Cleaners - Corporate Membership

HISTORY:

The Federation of Window Cleaners has a long and distinguished history dating back to 1914 when it was originally Founded the National Window Cleaners; Assurance Society. From this grew the present day federation established in 1947. It is composed of district members and governed by the following officers: Chairman, Vice-Chairman and Treasurer who, together with seven other members of the Federation form the Committee of management.

STATUS:

Employers Trade Association dedicated to the window cleaning industry.

AIMS:

The aims of the Federation are to promote the general interest of the trade either alone or in conjunction with any other organisations in achieving these objectives. The federation seeks to improve the image of the window cleaner endeavouring to support health and safety training and to promote the ongoing improvement of tools, Equipment and insurance for the industry. In almost any business or industry, a collective body of professionals will virtually always be more powerful than an individual person or company. This is especially true when the body is recognised by the government as an authority on the industry. Such organisations can do many things such as influencing regulations, advancing the interests of members, creating new operating methods to enhance profit and safety and other activities. An industry body provides credibility, expertise, influence and access. The window cleaning industry is no exception.

MEMBERSHIP:

Organisations who become Corporate Members demonstrate their commitment enthusiasm and Support for the Federation, their wish to observe the Federation's Code of Practice and be associated with the Federation's high standards in general.

Any person, partner in a firm or member of a Limited Company that has been trading for a period of at least two years – supplying goods or services to Members of the Federation shall be eligible to apply for Limited Membership (called "Corporate Membership" or Corporate members as appropriate) of the Federation. The Organisation will be admitted as a Corporate Member provided their application meets the acceptable requirements and after providing a sponsoring Corporate Member.

They may send a delegate to the AGM of the federation to express views and concerns, but have no voting rights. They may elect a representative from the ranks of corporate members to make representation to the executive council meeting (times and dates at Council's discretion) There will be no voting rights at council meeting.

Corporate members are eligible for discount on exhibition stand space and to promote Trade Show Seminars, Work- Shops and demonstrations. Their names are listed in a regular Corporate Membership listing in Window Talk, they are invited to provide editorial for publication on their Company's achievements, advice on training and education matters within the cleaning industry. Subject to editorial discretion of executive council.

Corporate Members have the right to use the Corporate Member Logo on their stationary and within advertisements.

Products and services of Corporate Members will be featured on the Federation's approved list of goods and services to members. They will be kept informed of UK and European Health & Safety issues, best business practice, education and training and technical expertise as the Federation obtains such information.
